$lacksquare$ Flash glucometer (including replaceable sensors) for the FreeStyle Libre *

* IMPORTANT
These devices and their components can not be pulled apart and must not pass
through the regular X-ray screening of objects and bags at security or be subjected to
a body scanner.
Walking through a conventional metal detector at security is not a problem.
