- Antidiabetics, in tablet or injectable form
- Insulin
- Insulin syringes
- Insulin pen(s) or an injectable antidiabetic drug and needles
- Blood glucose meter with test strips, and lancets to prick their finger
- Glucagon kit
- Cannulas and tubes for an insulin pump
- Insulin pump (including Omni Pod)***
- Continuous glucose monitor, including replaceable sensors and transmitters***
- Flash glucometer (including replaceable sensors) for the FreeStyle Libre***
- Other items _____

*** IMPORTANT**

These devices and their components can not be pulled apart and must not pass through the regular X-ray screening of objects and bags at security or be subjected to a body scanner.

Walking through a conventional metal detector at security is not a problem.
